STUDIO PLACEMENTS TO COMMENCE IN APRIL 2020

Contemporary Art Tasmania has four studio spaces in its premises at 27 Tasma Street, North Hobart. These studios are available by application to artists, arts writers, curators and others committed to a career in contemporary art. Spaces are awarded for a fixed period of 12 months, at minimal cost to the recipient.

ABOUT THE STUDIOS

All four studio spaces are situated on the 1st floor and are accessed by stairs. Studios have a window, heater, wireless internet access and lockable doors. There is 24hour access and spaces are protected after hours by an alarm system. Three of the studios are approximately 22m² in area, with the fourth being 9.6m². Running water is available from the ground floor.

OBLIGATIONS OF STUDIO HOLDERS

No rent or utility bills are associated with the studios. A \$300 deposit is required, fully refundable on vacating the studio without damage at the end of 12 months. Studio holders must also possess Public Liability Insurance.

It is hoped that studio artists will take maximum advantage of the awarded studio and, during their time here, form collegial relationships with staff, gallery visitors and fellow studio holders.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for a studio you must:

- Be an active practicing artist, or practitioner in a related field
- Not be enrolled in tertiary studies during the studio placement
- Be over 18 years of age
- Live in Tasmania
- Be a current member of Contemporary Art Tasmania

UNSUITABLE PRACTICES

Practices deemed unsuitable for these spaces may include those involving:

- Heavy equipment or materials
- Significant noise
- Dust
- Harsh chemicals or heavy metals

Past unsuccessful applicants are eligible to reapply.

Please submit the following:

- A cover letter outlining your plans or vision for the next year, as relating to your practice, indicating how a studio would assist your professional development (PDF - 1 page)
- CV with full contact details (PDF - 1 page)
- Support material - PDF format preferred but single images also accepted (no more than twelve images saved as JPEGs at a resolution of 72 dpi OR as a single PDF, one image per page)

Please provide a QuickTime showreel or a Vimeo/Soundcloud URL (and password if applicable) if your work is performative, employs moving image or sound. All support material must be clearly labeled, including artist's name, title of work, date of completion, medium and size.

SELECTION PROCESS

Studio applications are assessed by the Contemporary Art Tasmania Program Committee, a panel of professionals selected for their knowledge and experience of contemporary art. Applications are ranked using a peer-review process, in line with the following criteria:

- Clarity and relevance of personal and professional objectives for the year ahead
- Extent to which the award of a studio would clearly contribute to the applicant's professional development
- Demonstrated commitment to pursuing a professional practice in the arts

The committee's decisions are final. Applicants will be informed of the outcome of their submission one month from the application date. The four studio recipients will be publicly announced through Contemporary Art Tasmania's regular promotional channels.
